## Special Notice About This Year's Conference

The 2010 TN Chapter IAAI Conference will feature a great training opportunity for members. This year we will offer three tracks of classes. During the middle of the week, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday we will offer three tracks, the student will choose between the Basic and Advance tracks and they can attend a one day special Internet class for those 8 hours. Please choose the track that you wish to attend and place a check mark next to the track. The tracks are as follows:

### Basic Track:

For investigators or fire and police service personnel that have just begun their fire investigation training and need the basics to ensure they are able to do the job at hand. This class will cover the scientific method, fire patterns, origin and cause, cause analysis, documentation, evidence collection, fatal fires and vehicle fires. Even the seasoned investigator can learn from this class.

### Advance Track

This track will be courses that will assist the investigator that has been doing the job and give them the needed training in new techniques to enhance their knowledge in the career field and being better prepared for court testimony and expert cross-examination. These classes are presented by top instructors in the fire investigation community.

### Internet Track

This class is limited to 25 students each day and will be offered on Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday. You must also have an internet and wireless capable notebook or netbook to be able to do the activities in class. This course is geared to novice and advance computer literate investigators.
